I am excited to embark on another year of learning and growth with all of you, and I look forward to working together to create a school year filled with achievement, discovery, and joy.



Apply for School Admission

To apply for admission to our school, please submit the following application materials to admission@st-catherineacademy.com

Photocopy of applicant's Photo ID (Passport Pages)

Filled Registration Form

Transcript from the last three years (including English translation)

Conditional Offer

If you meet our school requirements, we will issue a conditional offer, tuition and fees invoice, and subsequent materials list through email.

Applying for Study Permit (Student Visa)

After paying full or partial tuition fees to our finance department, we will email you

- the official Letter of Acceptance,
- Receipt of your payment,
- guardianship documents for under 18 applicants

Refund Policy

If your application for student visa is refused, you must provide the letter of refusal issued by the Canadian Immigration Office, Letter of Acceptance, and tuition receipt to our school.

Upon receipt of these documents, we will refund 100% of the tuition fee less the none refundable application fee of \$500. However, we strongly encourage our students to pass over their file to our immigration lawyer. Our immigration lawyer will request answers from the Ministry and try to provide the missing or necessary documents.

Travel Arrangement

Upon receiving your student visa, you can start making

- travel arrangements
- airport pickup
- with the help of our school officials organizing your accommodation
- planning your meals

- buying medical insurance,

SCA versus Public Schools

Public School

- 1. Conducive language environment
- 2. Large class size (30-40 students in one classroom) with a reasonable tuition fee of \$16,000 + \$350 application fee.
- 3. No residence arranged for international students.
- 4. Longer graduation time:
- Students are placed in grades (9-12) based on their language ability, without considering their age or academic education from their home country. Students are only allowed to take high school credit courses after finishing all ESL levels. This unnecessary arrangement increases their graduation time by one or more years.

Our school

- 50% local students and 50% international student: favorable English language environment
- 2. VIP tutoring or small sized class (4-10 students) with reasonable tuition fees of \$16,000 Plus \$500 admin fees.
- 3. Intensive ESL course enables the students to finish their ESL courses much faster, saving their time and money.
- 4. Academic consulting on education plan and university placement.
- 5. Assists students with accommodation, medical insurance, airport pick-up and drop-off, visa renewal, ...

Credit Transfer:

International students' credit scores will be evaluated by the school authority, taking into account the courses they have taken in their home country. To compare the courses pursued by international applicants with Canadian courses of the same level and determine the actual credit score, the school requires a complete official transcript that includes this evaluation.

After Grade 11 : 22 credits
After Grade 12 : 24 credits



Complete the remaining credit courses (30 credits in total) required by Ministry of Education for Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD), including 6 University Preparation Courses



Choose target universities and submit OUAC application with the assistance of SCA Academic Advisor

Through a formal contract with students that outlines obligations and responsibilities, the program guarantees students admission to 12 selected universities in Canada.SCA provides extensive ongoing tutoring and support in course selection and university application. To be admitted to the SCA Guarantee Program, students must have completed junior high school or be current high school students. They must also pass an English entry test or interview and demonstrate good academic performance in their previous education. In addition, they should be willing to attend all after-hours tutoring sessions and work very hard.
